

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF REED, AMENDING THE PENALTY PROVISION OF CERTAIN IDENTIFIED TOWNSHIP ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE THAT A VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCES IS CIVIL AS OPPOSED TO CRIMINAL.

The Township of Reed, Dauphin County, hereby ordains as follows:

1. All of the below identified Township Ordinances have a penalty section which provides that a violation of the Ordinance is a criminal violation before a District Justice and provides for criminal penalties.
2. The Second Class Township Code, Act of May 1, 1933, as reenacted and amended on November 9, 1995, P.L. 350 No. 60, provides in Article XVI, Section 1601(c) that any person who violates or permits the violation of a Township Ordinance may be found liable in a civil enforcement proceeding commenced by the municipality and be required to pay the fine set by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors, plus all court costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees incurred by the municipality.
3. The Township of Reed hereby amends the following ordinances to provide that a violation of said ordinances shall subject the person, individual or other violator to a civil enforcement proceeding before the District Justice.
  - A. Junk Yard Ordinance - 1971
  - B. Sub-Division and Land Development Ordinance - 1990
  - C. Building Permit Ordinance - 1971
  - D. Flood Plain Ordinance - 1979; as amended.
  - E. Mass Gathering Ordinance #82-1 - 1982
  - F. Amusement Tax Ordinance #80-1 - 1980
  - G. Vector Control Ordinance
  - H. Trailers and Trailer Parks Ordinance - 1970
4. All provisions of the said ordinances described above are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance is hereby adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Reed Township on this 4<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1996, and shall become effective five (5) days thereafter.
