

ORDINANCE NO. 96-1

AN ORDINANCE OF REED TOWNSHIP, DAUPHIN COUNTY,
REQUIRING A SEWAGE PERMIT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF
INDIVIDUAL ON-LOT SEWAGE SYSTEMS.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Township of Reed, Dauphin County, as follows:

A permit shall be required for the installation of all individual on-lot sewage systems, including a system for a residential structure occupied or intended to be occupied by the property owner or a member of his immediate family on a contiguous tract of land, ten acres or more, if the owner of the property was the owner of record as of January 10, 1987. This requirement also applies to any ten acre parcel or lot subdivided from a parent tract after January 10, 1987.

For purposes of this Ordinance, the term 'immediate family' shall mean brother, sister, son, daughter, stepson, stepdaughter, grandson, granddaughter, father or mother of the property owner.

This Ordinance is enacted and ordained in conformance with the Act of December 14, 1994, P.L. 1250, No. 149, Section 3, 35 P.S. Section 750.7, effective December 15, 1995.

Adopted this 2nd day of January, 1996, and effective five days after enactment.
